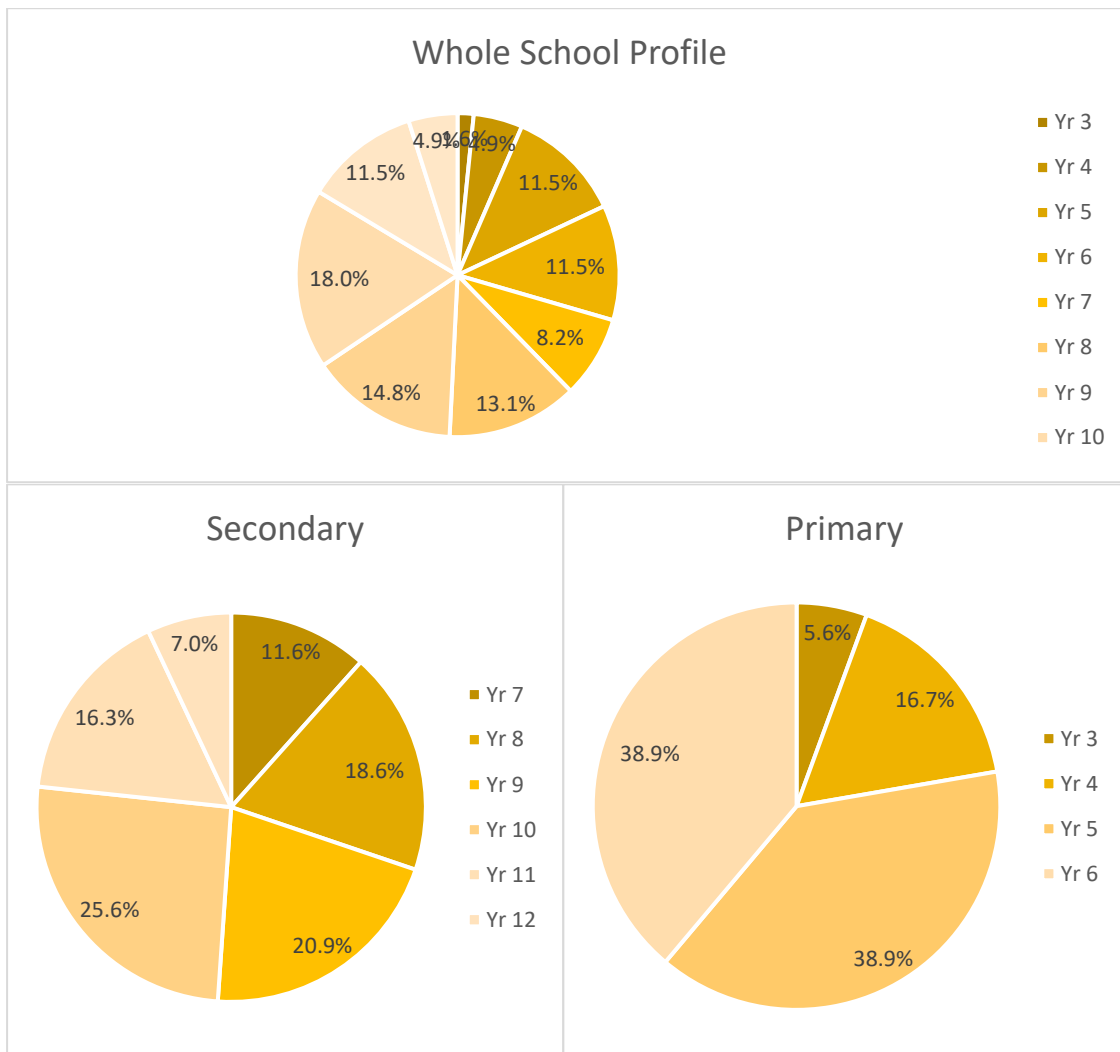

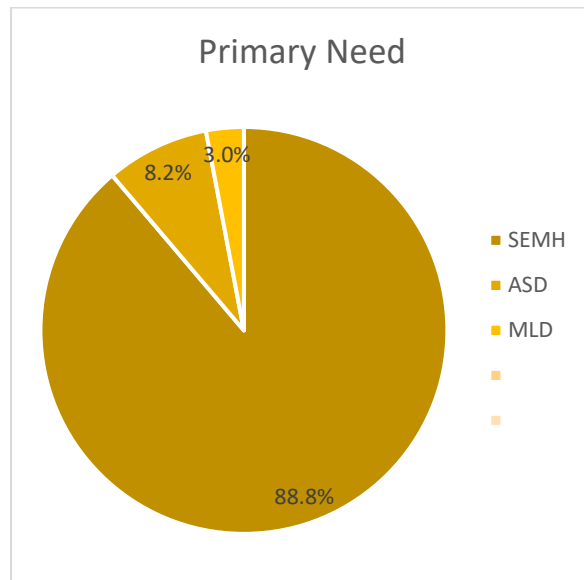

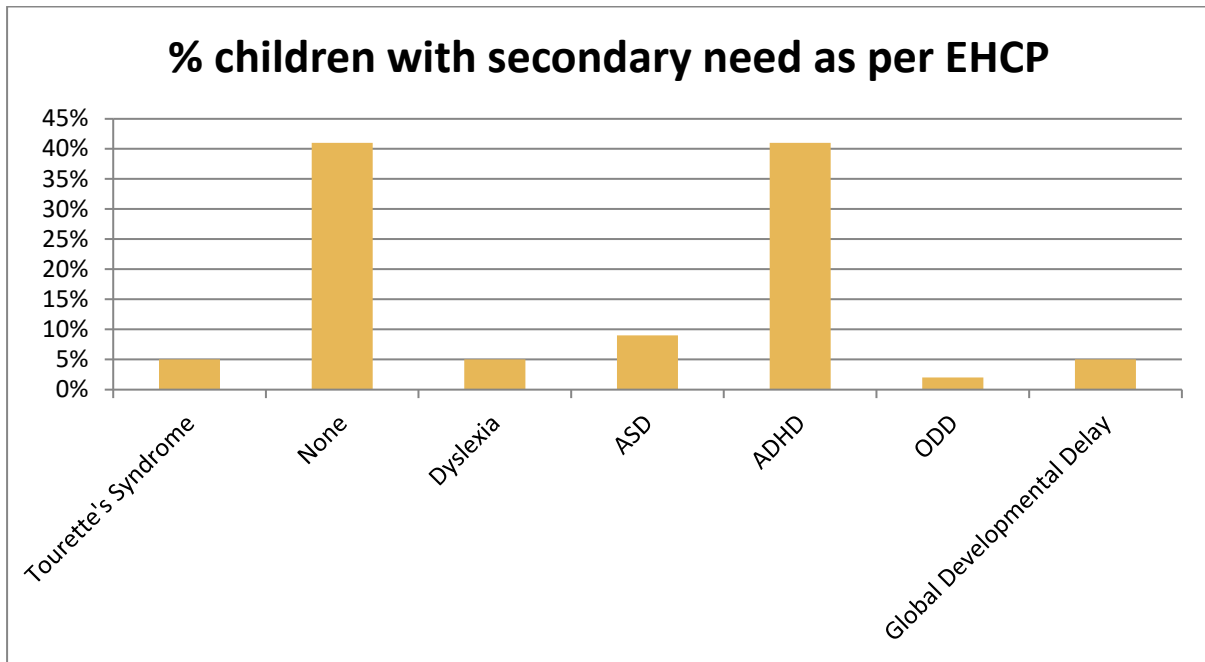

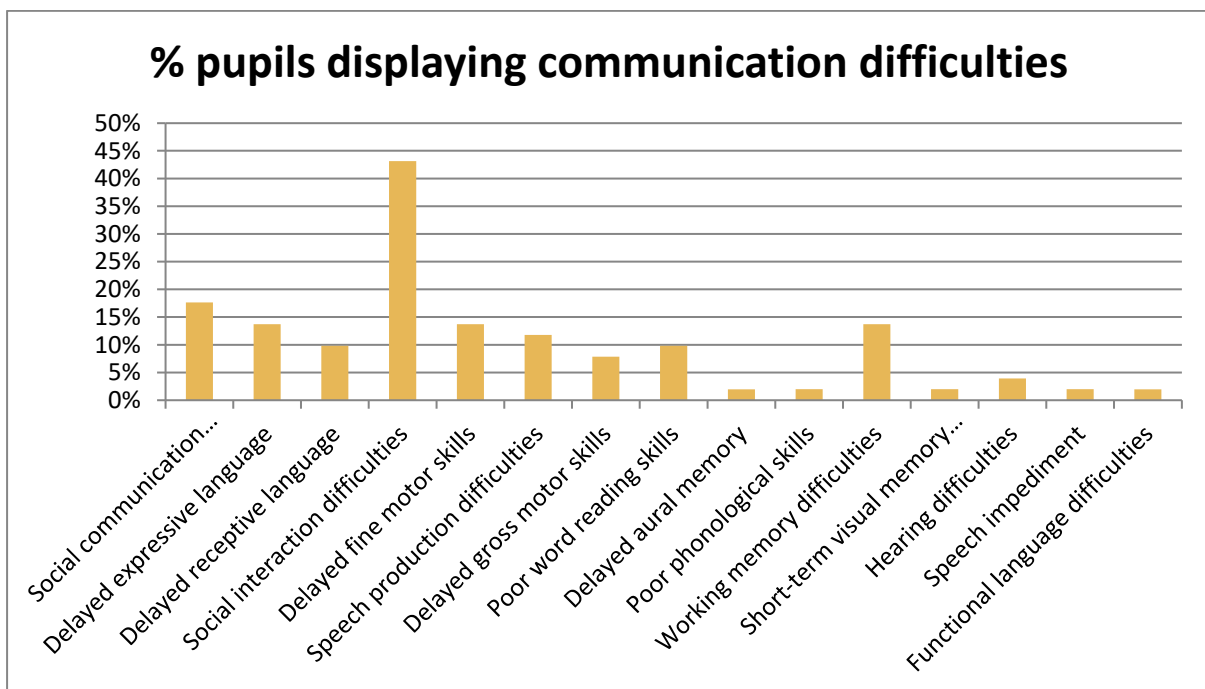


SEND Population – Secondary Need



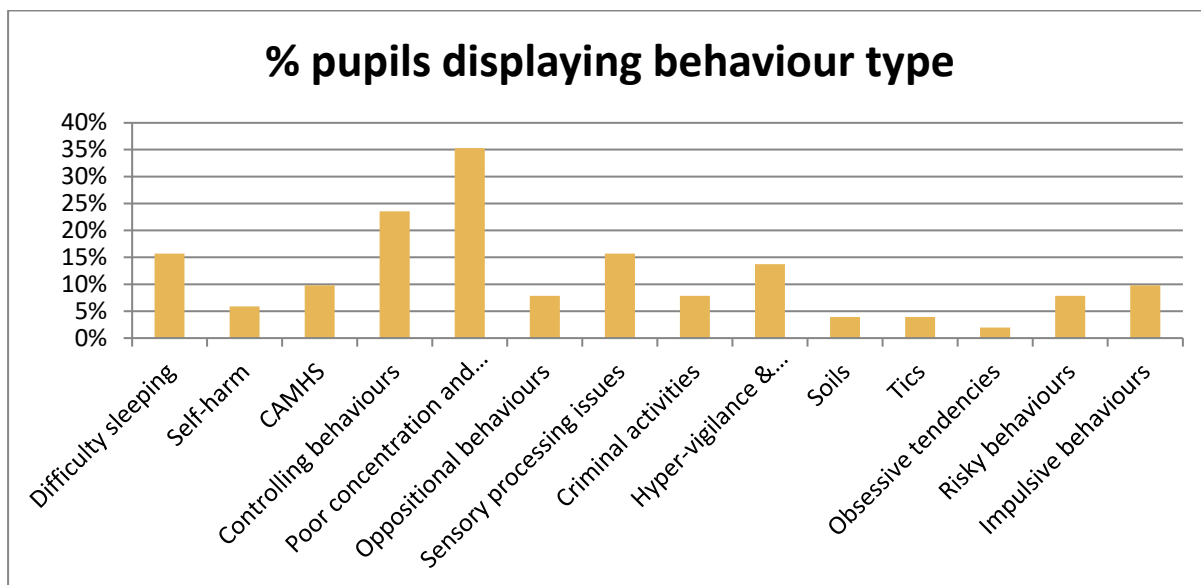
NB Some children have more than one secondary need recorded
