Read It Again: Repetition boosts comprehension, expression and engagement. The more we practice, the more independent our learner becomes.

- Each time you turn the page of a book or do an activity, pause and offer an open-ended comment. Then wait for and expect participation.
- Each time you complete the Recipe-Craft, wait for them to tell you the next step or have them tell a friend.

Introduce New Words: The more words we expose them to, the more they will know, use and understand.

- Use the search and edit features in Snap Core First* to find or add targeted words.
- If you can't find a word like blob, talk around it! Find words that describe it, like soft, blue or silly.






